1. The adult lights and gives all four torches.
2. A1 gives one ring at the *Sanctus*, one warning before the Consecration, and three distinct strokes at each elevation.
3. After the chalice elevation, Th returns alone.
4. **Ordinary branch:** on a non-fast day without faithful Communion, the torches leave then.
5. **Extended branch:** with faithful Communion, or on a fast day, remain through the first wine. The adult receives and extinguishes all four.

1. Mark the opening route, ferial and proper-text posture cues, and Creed.

4. Call every choice; every server repeats it before lineup.
5. **Prescribed branch:** it is not a free choice. If *Benedicamus* is appointed, stop this route and use the parish's separate procession sheet (not included).

4. **Finish:** return every object to its named place. The adult extinguishes flames and handles hot charcoal.

Answer

Receive, answer, pass, clear, reset

1. **Veil:** A1 receives and folds it.
2. **Pax:** A1 receives from the subdeacon, answers, and passes to A2; A2 answers and ends the lay chain. MC keeps the route clear.
3. **Communion branch:** if the faithful receive, A1 uses the bell and then the plate.
4. **Ablutions:** A1 serves both cruets; A2 moves the veil.
5. **Reset:** both clear and reset the credence. Keep every giver and receiver named.
